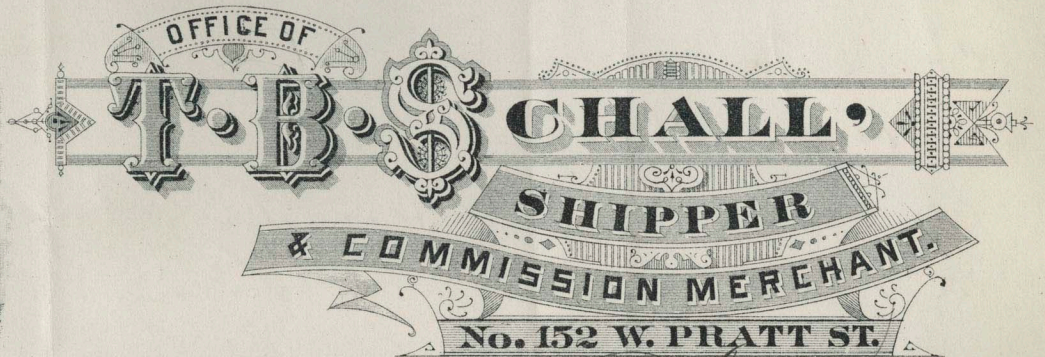

Mr. Upshur B. Quimby-

On my arrival here yesterday I found the deed for "Benson" at Thomas's. I had only time to drop you a postal. As I could not be at home until next week we thought it best to send the deed back to Accomack. I suggested in my card that ^{you} forward us a copy of power or attorney inserting the name of some one in your place who will act.
