

The above plat represents part of the north end of Cedar Island, located by W^m Gibb and Parker Barner, by virtue of Land Warrant No. 13,745, & surveyed by the Surveyor of Accomac, April 25, 1793, to contain Two Hundred & Fifty (250) Acres. The ground embraced by said survey has been carefully examined & none of the station points can be found. By request of W. B. Quincy & B. J. Rich, the extreme south point of Smead's Beach has been assumed as a starting point & the lines, marked A. B. & A. C. (taken from the original plat,) with the approximate correction for variation of the compass applied, are extended to the Surf boundary on the Sea Shore, ^{to} Long Post Creek.

The shore line represented on the plat is taken from a survey recently made by the undersigned.
