John Cummins, and by Cummins to W. B. Quincy.

1877. } L. J. Leleat's wife to Quincy, trustee of James I. Clark -
to secure \$220. with int. from date. Assigned by
Clark to W. B. Quincy.

Nov. 8, }
1881. } W. G. Fontenot's wife, Ida D., to Quincy, trustee of Geo. W. Leleat -
to secure \$107.50, with int. from date, + all further
sums. — Memo: This debt was settled by Dr
Leleat's purchase of Glenwood. See Dec from Fontenot's wife,
to Geo. W. Leleat.
