& describes it as on Cedar Isld. Will
Book June 1824 to July 1825.

Deed from Wm Gibb to Geo. Parker Barnes
dated 9th Apl. 1795, conveys 125 acres, being
 $\frac{1}{2}$ of the quantity of Wm Gibb's patent for
250 A. dated July 25, 1794.

Wm Gibb's Patent, dated July 25, 1794,
grants 250 A., pursuant to Treas. Warrant
No. 13,745, "adjoining Cedar Isld, bounded by
Long Boat Creek, Landing Cut, Metompkin
Inlet & Snead's narrows." See Surveyor's
