

Tyler's land.

1. Sev. Tyler's Will, 25th Jan'y, 1821 - leaves land bought of Stth Warrington's Exec^s to be sold.
2. Warrington's Exec^s to Sev. Tyler. 14th Feb^r, 1815. "Northwardly, & eastwardly, by the road leading from Pymptreque & Bluehill Neck to Swansea, and a branch (formerly a mill pond) wh. separates the same from the land of John G. Jones and William Seymour, Southwardly by the Canal belonging to the heirs of Lillth P. Townsend & Wm. Hamdenford." Devised to be sold by Stth Warrington's Will.
3. Stephen Warrington's Will. - Day of - 1814 - Devises land to be sold -
(John Warrington's Will, 1788 to 1794, shows nothing but that he was father of Stephen Warrington)
